## Questions to break the ice!

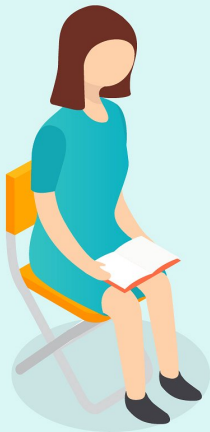
